CHÂTEAU DE SAINT COSME Condrieu 2017 - 95 points

«Bold, with quince, lemon curd, creamed pear, apricot and white peach flavors lending range and weight. Verbena and warm brioche details infuse the lush finish. Showy.»

CHÂTEAU DE SAINT COSME Côte Rôtie 2017 - 94 points

«Dark and winey, with olive and bay leaf-laced grip running underneath a core of steeped black currant and blackberry pâte de fruit notes. Singed mesquite hints swirl through the finish.»

«Lively mesquite and black tea notes give this aromatic complexity, with the core of black cherry and plum fruit taking on a nice mulled hint. Offers good juicy energy.»

CHÂTEAU DE SAINT COSME CDR Saint-Cosme 2018 - 89 points (Smart Buy)

«Lively savory, lavender, cherry and black currant notes mix in this friendly, open-knit wine, which reveals a tug of dark earth at the end.»

DOMAINE DE SAINT COSME IGP«Les Deux Albion» Blanc 2018 - 89 points

«Plump and open, featuring Cavaillon melon, green plum and white peach flavors, lined with honeysuckle and macadamia nut notes. Offers a rounded, friendly finish.»
