Château de Rouanne 2019 "Guerin" Rating: 92

Rich and warm in style, with a velvety flow to the mix of violet, plum paste, black currant compote and licorice root notes, while a tarry edge flows underneath. Ends with grippy texture and extra hints of bay leaf and tobacco amid the fruit. Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre. Best from 2023 through 2029. 315 cases made, 157 cases imported. — JM Issue: Apr 30, 2022 Wine Spectator
