2017 — 91 POINTS (Jason Wilson, Vinous)

This is an energetic, well-made Pinot Noir. Light garnet. Fresh, fruity nose at first, but notes of licorice hint at darker things. The freshness carries through the palate of wild blackberry and plum; earthier notes emerge at midpalate - bramble, cedar and forest floor. A touch of campfire on the finish. Good aging potential here, and great value. (Dec 2019)
