The oak is forthright on the nose. Tannins are upright, structured and crisp. Full-bodied, juicy and generous, there's some good drive and focus beneath the oak, and it finishes long. More depth than most, but will take time for the terroir and fruit to rise above the oak. Single vineyard Grenache planted on limestone marl. No destemming and 12 months maturation in French oak barriques: 20% new, 50% one-year-old, 30% two-year-old. Unfiltered.
