

## *Le Poste 2012*

### **Wine advocate**

90 points - Fresh and lively, yet with additional purity and focus, the 2012 Cotes du Rhone Le Poste Blanc (the Le Poste vineyard is essentially 4 terraces, with one of the terraces planted with white varieties) is mostly Clairette and gives up notions of poached pears, citrus blossom and hints of green fruits in its medium-bodied, pure and balanced personality. It has solid mid-palate depth and should hold nicely for 2-3 years, possibly longer (drink it though).
